She also said that she talked with Angie Kline and the County has the money to get this paving job finished this year. George Streeter (in summary) commented about Act 51 being reconsidered and also said that every time you buy gas you pay for the roads. He asked that this be set aside a week to see if there were any changes to the Act 51. Buller explained no money from Act 51 goes to any local roads. Hill also explained that the County got money not too long ago and nothing went to local roads. Dougherty explained that you can't count on the State for help and shouldn't miss this opportunity to move forward. There were many more comments on how bad the road was and needed to be repaired. Clerk Myers read a letter that was received from a resident on Singletree Lane. Public comment on everyone paying 2 mills to the Library forever and ever and he thinks we should put that back on the ballot to get the 2 mills back and then put that towards the roads.
