January has been a busy month for the department. We had a number of medicals and officers also investigated a number of opioid overdoses. One of them was a deadly overdose that officers are currently investigating and, with the South West Enforcement Team, an arrest of the suspected supplier has been made. More investigation is taking place. Officers also responded to an arson car fire at the Meijer Store on Beckley Rd. The suspect then tried to break in to the pharmacy and set other areas of the garden center on fire. From there, he went to the Meijer gas station and started a fire in one of the bathrooms, however, it extinguished itself. From there, he went to WalMart and stole items from the store. Our officers and the fire truck responded at which time, the suspect elected to ram the front of the fire truck causing extensive damage. He then tried to flee the scene and in so doing he hit the rear and side of the truck causing more damage. He was subsequently apprehended and is pending a multitude of charges.

Fire continues to be busy with medicals and our on-going training. I cannot thank our part-paid fire fighters enough for their dedication to our township. I am happy to report that Clarke Lawson is home and is doing quite well considering everything he went through. He continues to recover and we know it will be awhile before he can return to work.
